Welcome to the Adult Winter Reading Program of the **Whitehall Township Public Library!** (This is open to ages 18+.) To participate, you must register for our reading program online or at the front desk. Registration and book logging both begin January 15 and end on March 15. Come to our wrap-up party on March 27 at either 1 p.m. or 6 p.m. to discuss what you read.

At our wrap-up party, we will hand out small gifts to any program participant who reads **at least one book**, adds it to his reading log, and returns that log to the library by March 15 at 5 p.m. (There is a paper log attached, but if you register and log books online, we receive that information automatically.)


There is an additional **reading challenge** that you may complete to be entered to win an additional prize. You must complete the challenge and return it by on March 15 at 5 p.m. See next sheet for details.

Read a book with a cold or wintery word in the title.	Write a winter poem or short story.	Read a book set in South America.	Have some winter fun (like ice skating or snowman building).	Read a book about a trip or some form of transportation.
Learn about a winter or holiday tradition from another culture.	Read a book set in Europe.	Go somewhere you've never been before.	Read a book set in Asia.	Play or watch a winter sport. (Hint: The Olympics are Feb. 9-25.)
Read a book set in multiple countries.	Read an old journal (or start one if you don't have one).	 Free!	Try something you've never tried before.	Read a book originally written in another language.
Swap holiday memories with someone.	Read a book set in Africa.	Learn something new about another place or culture.	Read a book set in Australia/Oceania.	Learn about someone or something that lives in the cold.
Read a book set in the winter.	Give something warm to someone else or a charity.	Read a book set in either Mexico or Canada.	Do a winter-themed craft or art project.	Check out one of our databases relating to other cultures.*

*The library has some databases for people who like to learn about other places, whether or not they can travel there. The big ones are **AtoZ the World** (about other countries), **AtoZ World Food** (about food from other countries), and **Rosetta Stone** (for language learning). Of course, if you use any of our databases to learn about another place, it'll still count.

This contest is open to anyone who reads at least one book in our Adult Summer Reading Program. If you wish to participate, you may return this card to the library with your name and phone number by Thursday, March 15 at 5:00 p.m. to be eligible for the prize. (Note: Each book or event may only be used for one Bingo square apiece.)
